LIFETIME LEARNING

- Serve ages kindergarten through young adult with adaptive year-round academic enrichment including:
 - Homework help
 - Individual learning plans
 - Parental engagement
 - Math/reading/digital literacy diagnostics
 - Community partnerships
 - Individual tutoring daily for all K-5 students
 - Bible curriculum emphasizing peacemaking skills, Scripture memory, and race relations
 - Trauma-informed approach to behavioral management
 - Attendance at parent/teacher or guidance meetings
 - Bilingual staff on team
 - Project Room for interest-based, self-directed creativity
 - Enrichments include rotations in collaborative art, financial literacy, and physical fitness

HEALTHY COMMUNITY

- Celebrate people through fun neighborhood gatherings that incorporate listening, gratitude, and socialization
- Offer opportunities for all ages to pursue 5-2-1-0 goals (5 servings of fruits and vegetables, 2 hours of screen time, 1 hour of vigorous activity, and 0 sugary drinks)
- Give the gift of giving through Neighborhood Christmas Store
- Develop Kingdom-focused relationships through individual and small group mentoring/discipleship activities in preparation for Gathering Place setting
- Offer more prayer opportunities

FINANCIAL CAPABILITY

- Provide year-round financial capability instruction for all ages
- Prepare youth for future skills-based employment through access to digital literacy software
- Offer employment and next steps coaching for older high school/young adult micro-interns
- Provide summer Workforce Lab for high school students that incorporates soft job skills building, career/education explorations, volunteer service, and financial capability practice with real consequences
- Promote generosity by encouraging neighborhood volunteer hours and by benefiting others through group savings and service projects

DESIRABLE NEIGHBORHOOD

- Collaborate with community partners on behalf of Parker Street and North Lake Wire neighborhoods
- Connect residents to resources
- Complete renovation of structure on Myrtle St to become affordable housing duplex rental
- Form plan to increase affordable housing rentals on existing lots
- Encourage formation of Parker Street Neighborhood Association

2021 Accomplishments



91 students offered 1,204 hours of academic enrichment. 3,460 hot lunches and 6,860 healthy snacks served during Summer Camp. Yum! Volunteers made the difference!
